Size guide :

To help you choose the correct and best adapted flight suit for yourself, you will find the chart guide below for proper sizing based on your stature and weight. These numbers are purely indicative and we suggest you trying the suit prior any purchase.

Please, look at the schematic to find the corresponding measurements.

We wish to bring and focus your attention on two points :

- 1 / If you have the opportunity to fly during the winter or if your playground warrants you wearing adequate thermal protection, it will be of utmost importance to take it into account when choosing the correct size to be comfortable in your suit.
- 2 / If you must base your measurements in part on your leg length, keep in mind that our flight suits were designed for the paragliding activity (= seating posture) thus cut with a greater leg length for better wind protection.

Care and Maintenance

The materials used for your flight suit are of the highest quality and will allow for easy maintenance while keeping their original technical characteristics for as long as proper care is maintained. Your flight suit is machine washable, while respecting a 30° C maximum temperature (to prevent deterioration of the micro-porous coating). Warning : do not use softeners or chlorine bleach and do not place in a dryer.
